The date of the is the 1st of April 1921.

The characters, whoever they may be, will have been hired, asked nicely, blackmailed or whatever else it takes to look into the cases of a number of disappearing children in Arkham.

This has been arranged by one Lady Jane Simpson, a socialite of mixed reputation. She had arranged a large house in the Richmond area of Arkham for the characters to base their investigations from and has provided a dossier of information for the characters to start from.

## Missing Children

- Ladislav Wolejko - Missing 29th of April 1918, male aged two. Never found.
- Kendrick Velo - Missing 29th of April 1913, male aged one and six months. Found in Meadow Hill, gutted in the manner of a fish, part eaten by a rat like animal on 1st May.
- Irwin Sinkovich - Missing 29th of April 1912, male aged three. Found in Meadow Hill, gutted in the manner of a fish, part eaten by a rat like animal on 1st May.
- Merrill Maliska - Missing 29th of April 1911, male aged two. Found in Meadow Hill, gutted in the manner of a fish, part eaten by a rat like animal on 1st May.

Similar events have happened every few years from 1693. Not every year the longest gap being a ten year period between 1734 and 1744.
